The Montana Outdoor Recreation Summit returned! Co-hosted by the University of Montana's Institute for Tourism and Recreation Research (ITRR), W.A. Franke College of Forestry and Conservation, and Montana Access Project, this 2+ day event is dedicated to exploring the conservation, economic, and social aspects of outdoor recreation in Montana. We discussed the importance of preserving our natural resources for future generations, examining the economic impacts of outdoor recreation, and promoting diversity, equity, and inclusion in the outdoors.

To adequately capture the unique areas of Montana and their different needs, the project is engaging with each travel region to develop six independent resiliency plans that will ultimately braid into a state-wide plan.
